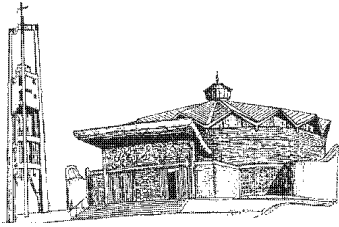

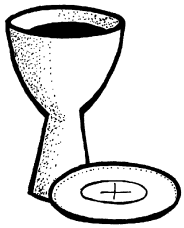
NEXT SUNDAY: Youth Group – day out to St Anne's

WORD OF LIFE

The kingdom of heaven is like a merchant in search of fine pearls; on finding one pearl of great value, he went and sold all that he had and bought it. (Matt. 13: 45-46)

This was not the first time the disciples had found themselves facing a radical demand – they must leave *everything* in order to follow Jesus: everything most precious to them, like family affections, financial security, certainty for the future. But Jesus' demands are not pointless or absurd. In place of 'everything' lost there is an 'everything' found, which is inestimably more precious. Each time Jesus asks something he promises to give much, much more, a superabundance. So in this parable he assures us of a treasure that will make us rich forever. And if it may seem a mistake to leave what is certain for what is uncertain, what is sure for a mere promise, let's thinking of that merchant. He knows that the pearl is extremely precious and he waits confidently for what its sale will bring. Likewise, whoever wants to follow Jesus knows and sees, with the eyes of faith, what an immense gain it is to share with him the inheritance of the kingdom as a result of having left everything, at least in a spiritual sense. God offers everyone a chance like this in life so they can grasp it.
