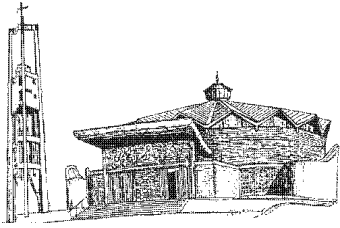

## WORD OF LIFE

**Stay awake and pray that you may not come into the time of trial; the spirit indeed is willing, but the flesh is weak. (Mt 26:41)**

Now, Jesus tells us, the first condition for overcoming a trial, any trial, is to be watchful.
