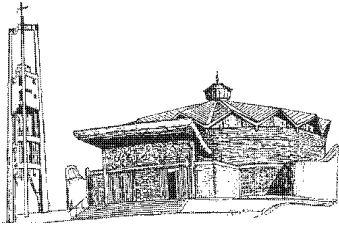

WORD OF LIFE

Keep awake therefore, for you know neither the day nor the hour. (Mt. 25:13)

Jesus had just left the Temple. The disciples proudly pointed out the grandeur and the beauty of its buildings. And Jesus replied: 'You see all these do you not? Truly I tell you, not one stone will be left here upon another. ' Then he went up the Mount of Olives, sat down, and looking over Jerusalem, began to speak about the destruction of the city and the end of the World.
