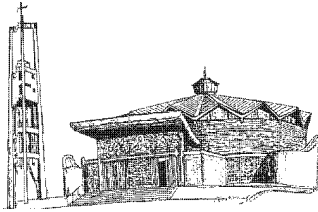

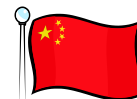
**Cake sale** - following 9.30 am Mass on Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> April to raise funds for the Mums and Toddlers group.
