WORD OF LIFE

You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind (Mt 22:37)

How then can we live this command of Jesus? Certainly by keeping up a relationship with God as his children and his friends, but above all by doing what he wants. Our attitude to God, like that of Jesus, is to be always turned towards the Father, listening to him, in obedience, so as to carry out his work, that alone and nothing else. This asks us to be thoroughly drastic, because it is not possible to give God less than everything: *all* our heart, *all* our soul, *all* our mind. And this means to do well and completely the action that he is asking of us.
