Fr. Ambrose died peacefully in St. Catherine's hospice last Tuesday 14th June at 3pm. Those who were in Church on Sunday 5th June heard his goodbye message to his friends and fellow parishioners here. They will know that he spoke calmly from his wheel chair that the impending death he was facing is what our whole lives are for, and that he would continue to pray for us from heaven as he did while on earth, and indeed awaits us there. If anyone wishes to pay a tribute to Fr. Ambrose there is a book in which to write on the table at the back of Church or outside the Blessed Sacrament Chapel. We hope soon also to have this possibility on the parish website.

Wednesday 29th June

- 4pm Simple Reception of Fr. Ambrose's body in Church. This will provide a chance to pray quietly for anyone who wishes. Please sign the list so there are people in Church till 7.15pm.
- 7.15pm Evening mass linked with vespers for Fr. Ambrose

Thursday 30th June

- 11.30am Funeral Mass for Fr. Ambrose

Friday 1st July 12 noon Funeral Mass with his body at Hexham and Newcastle Cathedral
